

Registration Information:

The cost of the program is \$250.

Registration includes: Workshops, Ropes Course field trip, daily lunch & snacks, FLI T- shirt, and closing ceremony luncheon ticket.

Full and partial sponsorships are available on an as needed basis. To be considered for sponsorship, the parent or guardian must submit a letter explaining the need for financial assistance. Please note that a follow up phone call may be necessary to further assess the need for sponsorship.

Applications are due by May 31st, and notifications will be made by **June 15th**. Upon acceptance into the program, applicants must reserve their space with a minimum deposit of \$50 by June 30th (all deposits are non-refundable), otherwise their spot will be forfeited and given to the next eligible applicant. The remaining balance of \$200 must be paid by July 31st.

FLI Orientation: There will be a mandatory parent/ student orientation on Wednesday, August 5, at **7pm**. Attendance is required for participation.

FLI Closing Awards Luncheon: There will be a closing ceremony held on Saturday, August 22nd, at 12pm. The program will include presentations from the FLI girls, and an award ceremony. Tickets for friends & family of the FLI girls will be \$20, and must be purchased by August 14th for session 1 participants & August 18th for session 2 participants.
