

## Action Partnership Food Drive

Here is a list of products needed to continue to provide for Orange County:

- . Peanut butter
- . Jelly, jam (strawberry or grape)
- . Canned stew
- . Canned meats (chicken, tuna, chili, etc...)
- . SpaghettiO's (any type)
- . Bag of rice, beans, or pasta
- . Canned pasta sauce (no glass)



### Rules:

- The easiest way to figure out what to donate is to make sure that you donate items that you would like to eat.
- Canned meats (tuna, chicken, chili, etc...) must be at least 12 oz.
- Do not give food that has been in the back of your pantry for the past 5 years.
- Do not donate cans of food that are not commonly eaten such as lima beans or sauerkraut just because it only cost \$0.50 for the can.
- Use this philosophy: at any moment the food bank could be in desperate need of help. What kinds of foods would you like to eat? What would you not like to eat?

Five (5) of any combination of items listed above is worth one (1) hour of community service. A maximum of three (3) hours can be earned for this project.
