Nova Group, Inc., a prime contractor, requests sub bids from all interested small business entities, Small Business Administration (SBA) certified small disadvantaged business entities, including minority and women-owned, HUBZone small business entities, veteran-owned small and service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses in the following areas:

Description:

This procurement is to provide for a Design/Build, Design/Bid/Build Multiple Award Construction Contract (MACC) for new construction, repair, alteration, and renovation of marine waterfront facilities located with the NAVFAC Northwest area of responsibility, including but not limited to, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Alaska and Wyoming. However, it is anticipated that the majority of the work will be performed in Washington.

The work includes, but are not limited to piers, wharves, quay walls, bulkheads, sea walls, dry docks, boat ramps, docks and marinas, shore protection, rip rap, breakwaters, wave attenuation, mooring dolphins, buoys, primary and secondary fendering, pile driving, sheet piles, and dredging and disposal. The work also includes the design and construction of all utilities and other facilities in the marine waterfront area and/or related to marine waterfront operations, to support Navy vessels and port operations.

The procurement consists of one solicitation with the intent to award up to five Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Construction Contracts to the responsible offerors whose proposals, conforming to the Request for Proposal (RFP), will be most advantageous to the Government resulting in the Best Value, price and technical factors considered. Award of task orders will be on a firm fixed price basis.

Supply Items Include:

Waste Disposal, Fuel, Chemical Toilets, Concrete, Aggregates, Trucking, Surveying, precast items (piles, manholes, trench covers), Steel piling – Pipe and Sheet types; Pipe, valve and fitting Vendors for Electrical, Fuel, Sewer, Steam, Compressed Air, Water and Storm Drain systems.

Soil excavation for utility trenches. Heavy civil work to install steel and concrete piles of various types and sizes for the new pier and new quay walls.
