



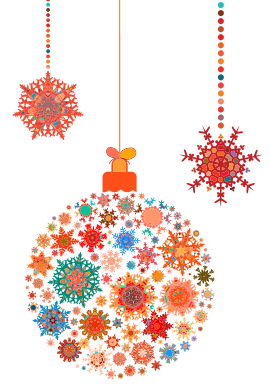
**Kamwenge Secondary

Its Thanksgiving and I am personally thankful for your generous participation supporting Partners in Mission (PIM). Since its inception in 2006 your gifts have grown Kamwenge Secondary and Vocational School (KSVS) from a kernel of an idea to a campus that serves over 650 students.

PIM's most visible program, KSVS, opened its doors in February 2007, serving the community of Kamwenge District of Uganda with just 14 students. Our original vision was to be a transforming presence in the community made up of small villages inhabited by indigenous subsistence farmers.

As our students prosper and graduate from KSVS, we are facing a new challenge. With typical costs for additional education being from \$1,000 to \$3,000 annually for two to three year programs some of our graduates need additional financial support to complete their University degrees.

In order to address this growing need, we are designating our Christmas giving to build a Scholarship fund providing assistance for our graduates' higher education.
