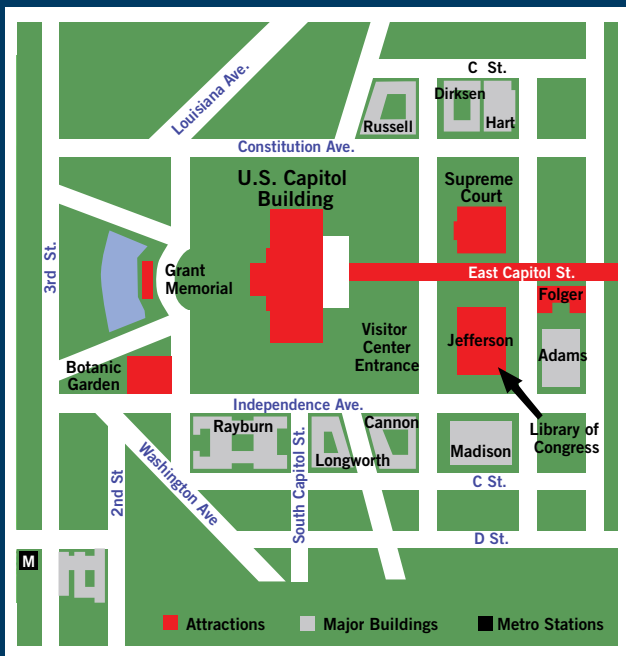


Map of Capitol Hill
