The Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies (KHS) at the University of Regina is accepting applications to its MSc and PhD graduate program.

Eligible students must have a degree in Kinesiology, Human Kinetics, Recreation, or Sport Management or equivalent (minimum 70% GPA). Certification as a Canadian Society for Exercise Physiology- Exercise Physiologist (CEP), Personal Trainer (CPT) or National Strength and Conditioning Association- Strength and Conditioning Specialist (CSCS) are preferred but not necessary. Funding is available (up to \$16,000 CAD/year – additional funding during summer may be an option) and students will be expected to provide assistance with the development, marketing, and delivery of community fitness programming within the URFit and KHS non-credit portfolios.
