

Long-term Basic Bible Study Possibilities

Disciple 1: Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study: This **34-week study** serves as the basis for all other Disciple-family studies. It covers the entire biblical story from Creation to the New Jerusalem.

Disciple 2. Into the Word, Into the World: This **32-week study** offers a deeper examination of Genesis, Exodus, Luke and Acts, emphasizing all experiences of life as opportunities for faithful witness and service

Disciple 3. Remember Who You Are: In this **32-week study**, students examine the connection (through the Prophets and the Letters of Paul) between memory and identity as the people of God. Students will find common themes of calls to remember, to repent, for renewal and for community.

Disciple 4. Under the Tree of Life: This **32-week study** explores what it means to have the promise of shelter, security and rest in God's love. The Old Testament Writings, the Gospel of John, the Epistles of John, James, Jude and Revelation, will guide the students to rest in God's love.

Special Series Possibilities

Jesus in the Gospels: This **30-week study** invites believers to encounter the Jesus who is both hard to ignore and hard to control, as portrayed in Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Christian Believer: This **30-week study** focuses on classical teachings of the Christian faith through the use of words, symbols, and hymns. This demanding study calls the believer into deep reflection on fundamental issues of the Christian faith.

Short-term Basic Bible Possibilities

Invitation to the New Testament: In this **8-week study**, students learn: Kingdom principles (Sermon on the Mount); the meaning of "Gospel" for Christianity and the wider culture; how this impacts us; and the meaning of resurrection and Jesus' death and resurrection.

Invitation to the Old Testament: In this **8-week study** students follow how God's People are created through Abraham, tested in the Exodus story (a fundamental for Jews and Christians!) and are led to into a covenantal relationship with God. From this the prophets speak, the Temple is lost and the Jewish identity is shaken...but Hope is found, as the Hebrew people await the coming of the Messiah.

The Newest Disciple-series Bible Study

Covenant Bible Study is a **24-week**, in-depth study engaging participants in conversations about this unique and special relationship as we study the Bible together. A "covenant" speaks to an enduring commitment between God and God's fruitful people. It is based on the understanding that it is through community—through shared reflection and engagement—that we can best discover the Bible's transformative power.

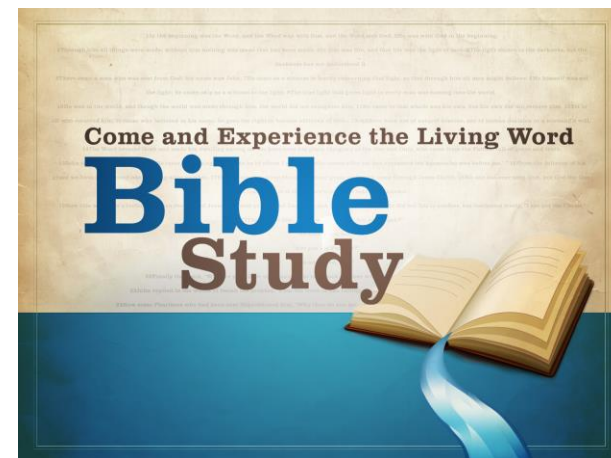
