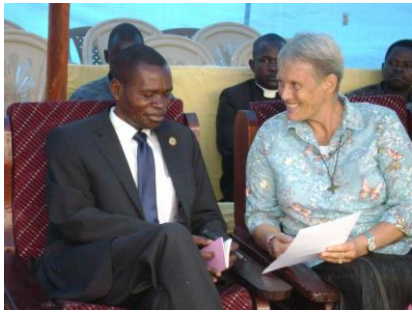


'Precious' Principal Praised
