

Muscular Dystrophy UK and the Royal College of General Practitioner (RCGP) have come together to develop a new online eLearning module for GPs. The purpose of this module is to provide helpful information on the presentation and primary care management of musclewasting conditions.

The module is case-based, and covers how to recognise and manage some of the more common muscle wasting conditions.

Content

The module focuses particularly on the following muscle-wasting or neuro-muscular conditions:

- Duchenne muscular dystrophy
- Becker muscular dystrophy
- ♦ Charcot-Marie-Tooth disease (CMT)
- ♦ Facioscapulohumeral muscular dystrophy (FSH)
- ♦ Spinal muscular atrophy (SMA)
- ♦ Myotonic dystrophy
- Myasthenia gravis
- McArdle disease (acute rhabdomyolysis)

Outcomes


After completing this online eLearning module, you will be able to:

Charcot-Marie-Tooth disease is a peripheral nerve disease, characterised by foot/ankle deformities, hand/arm weakness, and rarely, diaphragm weakness. Referred and neuropathic pain are very common in this condition, as is fatigue. The condition can range from very mild to extremely severe. Although it is not usually life-threatening, it is definitely life-limiting, by restricting mobility, working capacity and reducing quality of life.
