

The Ohio State University (OSU) is seeking a Dean for the College of Medicine (COM). The College of Medicine is part of the OSU Wexner Medical Center (WMC). It is considered one of the most comprehensive preeminent academic medical centers in the United States.

The Ohio State University located in Columbus, Ohio is one of the nation's top-20 public universities and widely recognized for its top-rated academic medical center, premier cancer hospital, and comprehensive cancer center. As Chair of the Board of OSU Physicians, the faculty practice plan of the College of Medicine, the Dean provides leadership of the practice and administration of the clinical missions of the faculty in the College of Medicine. The Dean works collaboratively with the Chief Executive Officer of the OSU Health System, the Chief Financial Officer of the WMC, and the leadership of hospitals within the WMC.

The Dean leads the College of Medicine through innovative, effective and responsible management of college resources, and by leveraging WMC and University assets. The Dean also works collaboratively with the leadership of the WMC and the University, involving fellow deans, administrators, faculty, and staff. The Dean must demonstrate a personal communication style and integrity that fosters an environment of trust, teamwork, and accountability, as well as personal behavior that fosters innovation and excellence for all constituents within the College of Medicine, WMC and University.
