Guided by innovative leadership and a new blueprint for action, Thomas Jefferson University (TJU) and Thomas Jefferson University Health System are embarking on a new era of integration, collaboration, and transformative change. Foundational to this transformation is a new blueprint for strategic action to lead the region to a new level of health education, services, and care. This includes three interrelated pillars that guide One Jefferson's development:

- Academics - Thomas Jefferson University with its state-of-the-art academic health science programs and bench and translational research.
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship - An entrepreneurial private/public academic partnership including a startup incubator designed for speed to market of clinical innovation.
- Clinical Enterprise - A fully integrated health system comprised of a seamless regional network of inpatient and ambulatory sites supported by a fully aligned physician organization committed to value-based care and excellence in clinical outcomes. Envisioned is a fully aligned physician organization that includes Jefferson University Physicians (JUP), which encompasses 670 full-time faculty physicians and Jefferson Community Physicians, a new structure bringing together approximately 70 primary care physicians employed by the system; and independent physicians aligned through membership in the Jeffcare PHO, and/or the Medical Staff with One Jefferson today.

Reporting to the CMO of Jefferson Health System and working in a dyad relationship with the Senior Vice President of Jefferson Physicians, the SVP & Chief Clinical Officer – Jefferson Physicians serves as the primary physician executive with the leadership responsibility of overseeing clinical care for Jefferson Physicians, to include Jefferson University Physicians (JUP) and Jefferson Community Physicians.

In this critical role within the new structure, the SVP & Chief Clinical Officer – Jefferson Physicians will work in partnership with the Clinical Chairs to lead Jefferson Physicians' pursuit of 1) the highest possible standards of patient care and clinical effectiveness, 2) advancement of the One Jefferson strategy, and 3) market movement

to value-based reimbursement and partnerships with key payors and other community partners in the implementation of population-based care. The SVP & Chief Clinical Officer – Jefferson Physicians will, likewise, reaffirm and promote a culture of patient-centered care in which clinical outcomes are defined, measured, evaluated, and continuously improved.

Required Qualifications and Experience

- Doctorate of Medicine from an accredited School of Medicine and board certified by a board recognized by the American Board of Medical Specialties. Hold or eligible for medical licensure in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Demonstrated leadership stature and the ability to lead through both authority *and* influence. Ten years of experience, to include five years of senior leadership experience, within an advanced academic environment combined with proven communication, organizational, analytical, and relationship skills.
- Master's degree in public health or business is preferred.
- Clinical credibility (at least five years clinical practice experience) with a primary care (internal medicine or family medicine) background or a specialist with demonstrated understanding of the value and critical role that primary care plays in the future of the health delivery system.
- Experience in developing and implementing clinical pathways that lead to measurable improvements in clinical effectiveness.
- Prior knowledge and experience in cultural transformation at another academic medical center or large physician group practice with both faculty and community physicians.
- High level of experience with clinical informatics; experienced in the development and implementation of quality dashboards and the use of data to drive transformation. Specific experience in defining, collecting, and communicating relevant metrics to demonstrate effective process, clinical, and financial outcomes.
- A patient-centric approach with emphasis on high quality efficient care.
