The University at Buffalo has retained Merritt Hawkins to recruit the next Division Chief of Gastroenterology. Dr. Thomas Mahl is currently serving as the interim Chief and will be involved with the recruitment of the new director. There are currently four core faculty members within the department and five additional physician staff members, each with specific interests and focus within gastroenterology.

The incoming provider will have the opportunity to help build and develop an already successful department, including the recruitment of at least two additional faculty members to join their team. UB has a three-year gastroenterology fellowship program that accepts three new fellows per year. The fellows receive comprehensive training at multiple sites, including ECMC, Buffalo VA Medical Center, the Roswell Park Cancer Institute, Buffalo General Medical Center, and the Dent Tower GI Outpatient Office.

The incoming Chief of Gastroenterology can expect a practice mix of approximately 60% clinical and 40% Academic/Administrative responsibilities. The schedule can be flexible depending on the preference of the incoming Chief.



The department would welcome a candidate with a specific niche within gastroenterology. It is important for the Division Chief to not only be an excellent clinician, but to also offer superior leadership and teaching skills. The physician will mentor both residents and fellows at UB. Research and other academic pursuits are also encouraged.
