The Penn State Milton S. Hershey Medical Center (PSHMC) is a fully integrated teaching, research, patient care and public service institution that serves the healthcare needs of approximately 45 counties and four-and-a-half million people in fast-growing central Pennsylvania.

The Penn State Hershey campus includes, Penn State College of Medicine and Penn State Hershey Medical Center, a Magnet-designated 501-bed academic medical center with a 130-bed children's hospital. Reporting to the Chief Medical Officer, the Chief Quality Officer (CQO) will be a member of the senior leadership team and will lead the institutional focus for safety and quality and the processes, resources and culture that will elevate quality performance.

The CQO will work collaboratively with clinical leaders to guide the comprehensive, strategic and tactical planning and implementation of quality and safety programs on an inpatient and ambulatory basis across PSHMC. Required credentials include MD/DO from an accredited institution, with ACGME- approved residency program in any specialty area, and current Board Certification.

An advanced degree in healthcare or business related field is preferred. Ideally, candidates will have significant experience in a complex, high performing academic medical center in clinical process improvement, quality and safety.
