The impending retirement of the incumbent CMO has led to a national search for a successor. This position affords a visionary and dynamic physician executive the opportunity to join a healthcare enterprise that is characterized by a shared sense of purpose, high functioning leadership and a laser focus on the delivery of high quality, safe, cost effective care through accountability and collaboration. This has been most recently evidenced by Froedtert Hospital's recognition as a University HealthSystem Consortium top-performing academic medical center.

The CMO in concert with the senior leadership team will be responsible for setting and implementing a bold innovative agenda for excellence in the delivery of clinical services across the continuum. S/he will lead the clinical activities of the adult faculty practice and the academic medical center, implementing the strategic and operational initiatives of MCP and Froedtert Hospital. The CMO will work collaboratively with clinical leaders to guide the comprehensive, strategic and tactical planning and implementation of quality and safety programs on an inpatient and ambulatory basis.

The successful candidate will have substantive track record of leadership in a complex, high performing academic medical center. S/he will have an intimate knowledge of clinical practice, an understanding of the business of health care and will command the respect of peers and colleagues through professional achievement and fairness. A Doctor of Medicine degree is required and completion of a postgraduate medical education in an ACGME approved residency program in any medical specialty with current Board Certification. An advanced degree in health care or business related field is preferred. The CMO who will best succeed is one who is visible, proactive, decisive, an outstanding communicator and one who is able to build relationships across the organization to engage peers in delivering excellence in clinical care.
