The Neurology research and training programs of BUSM and BMC, and affiliates, will also be important responsibilities of the Chair as will maintaining the strong educational programs at the Boston University School of Medicine.

The Chair will be expected to have outstanding leadership and management skills and to merit appointment at the rank of Professor in the BU School of Medicine. The extraordinarily diverse patient population at Boston Medical Center presents a special obligation and opportunity to create programs that respond to the needs of culturally diverse and underserved urban patient populations.
