

CIDNA Tree Grant Program

CIDNA NRP funds are available to help residents promote the health of trees in the Cedar-Isles-Dean neighborhood.

PROGRAM DETAILS:

CIDNA will provide grants to reimburse property owners in the Cedar-Isles-Dean neighborhood up to 25% of the cost (maximum grant of \$250) of the following:

- **Tree removal.** Licensed professional removal of dead, diseased or hazardous trees or tree limbs from private property. Program does not include routine pruning for maintenance and shaping; the grant is limited to removal of tree limbs that are diseased or hazardous.
- **Tree treatment:** Licensed profession treatment of: elm trees to prevent Dutch Elm Disease; green ash trees to prevent or treat infestation by the Emerald Ash Borer; and/or oak trees to treat infestation by the Two-lined Chestnut Borer for trees on the boulevard and/or on the owner's private property.
- **Removal of buckthorn:** Licensed professional removal of buckthorn on private property.



Note: Grants are limited to one grant per property and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, as funds are available. Effective date as of June 21, 2013 (the solstice storm).

PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

- Property must be in the Cedar-Isles-Dean neighborhood.
- A licensed professional tree service contractor must be used for the services outlined in the Program Details section above.
- Grants are limited to one grant per property. Reimbursement will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis as funds are available.
- Property owner must complete the **CIDNA Tree Grant Application**. **Attach a copy of the invoice from the licensed tree care provider with receipt of payment.** Mail to:
