- 5) Do not put your feet on couches, chairs, or other structures not intended for shoes.
- 6) Respect the alcohol policy of Ferry Beach: the consumption of alcohol is restricted to the dining hall and private rooms.
- 7) Pick up after yourself and your family.
- 8) Do not destroy the dunes by walking on them.
- 9) Play with toys, balls, and Frisbees that are stored in the boxes near the volleyball court and return them there when you are finished with them.
- 10) Park in designated areas both in the Grove and on the campus.
