Ken and his wife, Carol, along with members of three other families who suffered similar losses, began International Cruise Victims. ICV represents victims of crime on cruise ships, their families and friends, and individuals concerned about the problems of victimization and disappearances on cruise ships. The goal of the organization is to contribute to growing a cruise industry where passengers and crew members are safe and secure from victimization while on board a cruise ship.
