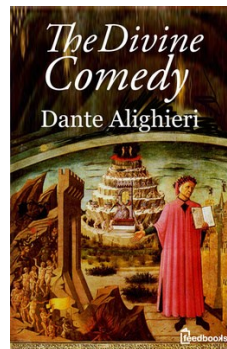
Senior High Mission Team Departs for Booneville, Arkansas
