Join Us for “Prayer in our Lives,” Wednesdays in June

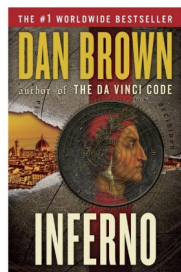

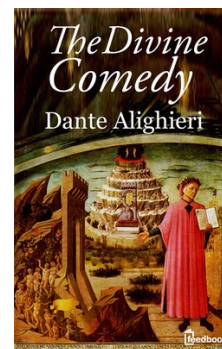


Will you help us grow the PVUMC Foundation?
