For Ellis, Colorado Kitchen Designs’ 1,200-square-foot showroom is a perfect opportunity for the firm to achieve “best in show.”

“It’s important that our clients feel comfortable in our showroom,” she explains. “When you walk in you hear friendly dogs barking, announcing your arrival. We even have past clients who stop by our showroom every time they are in the neighborhood simply to see the dogs!”

The firm’s product selection, however, is what really makes the showroom stand out.

“We specialize in providing cabinetry for all areas of the house, and offer a variety of product lines,” Ellis says.

The company carries lines from WoodHarbor Doors & Cabinetry, Holiday Kitchens, Legacy Debut Cabinetry, Bertch Cabinet and Shiloh Cabinetry, as well as countertop products, including Silestone, Okite, Zodiaq,

“If the client needs someone to supply cabinetry, we can easily provide it,” says Ellis. “If the client needs someone to help pick out every element of the space, such as paint, tile or countertops, we are able to provide these services as well. We put a lot of energy into making sure our contractors receive materials on time and create designs that work.”

With regard to appliances and plumbing supplies, the firm refers its clients to an appliance or plumbing showroom in the area.

“The most important factor is staying in budget while making sure the client is happy with the results,” she says. “At Colorado Kitchen Designs, it is our job to direct them to products and designs that will enable them to fulfill their dream project.”
