We are recruiting children (ages 5-17 years old) for our *annual day-camp* for children with cerebral palsy. They will learn techniques for improving their speech communication in the context of games, singing, and dramatic play, all in a fun and supportive environment full of opportunities to engage and communicate. Children will come to the Speech Production and Perception Laboratory before and after the program so we can measure their progress and provide feedback to parents. All participant information is kept completely confidential.
