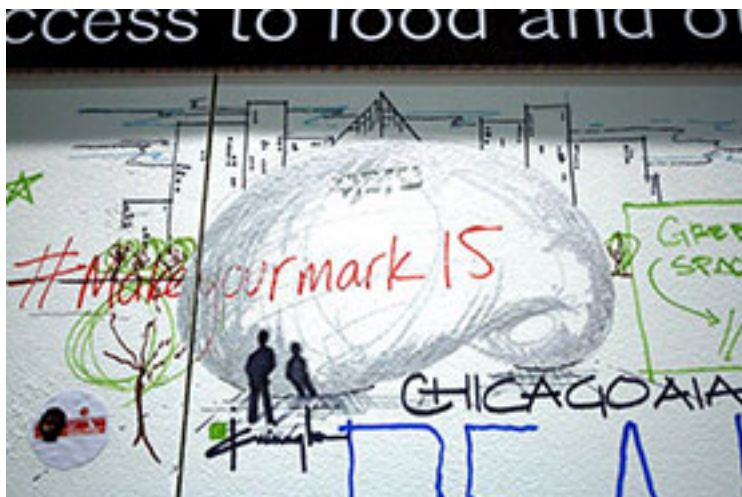

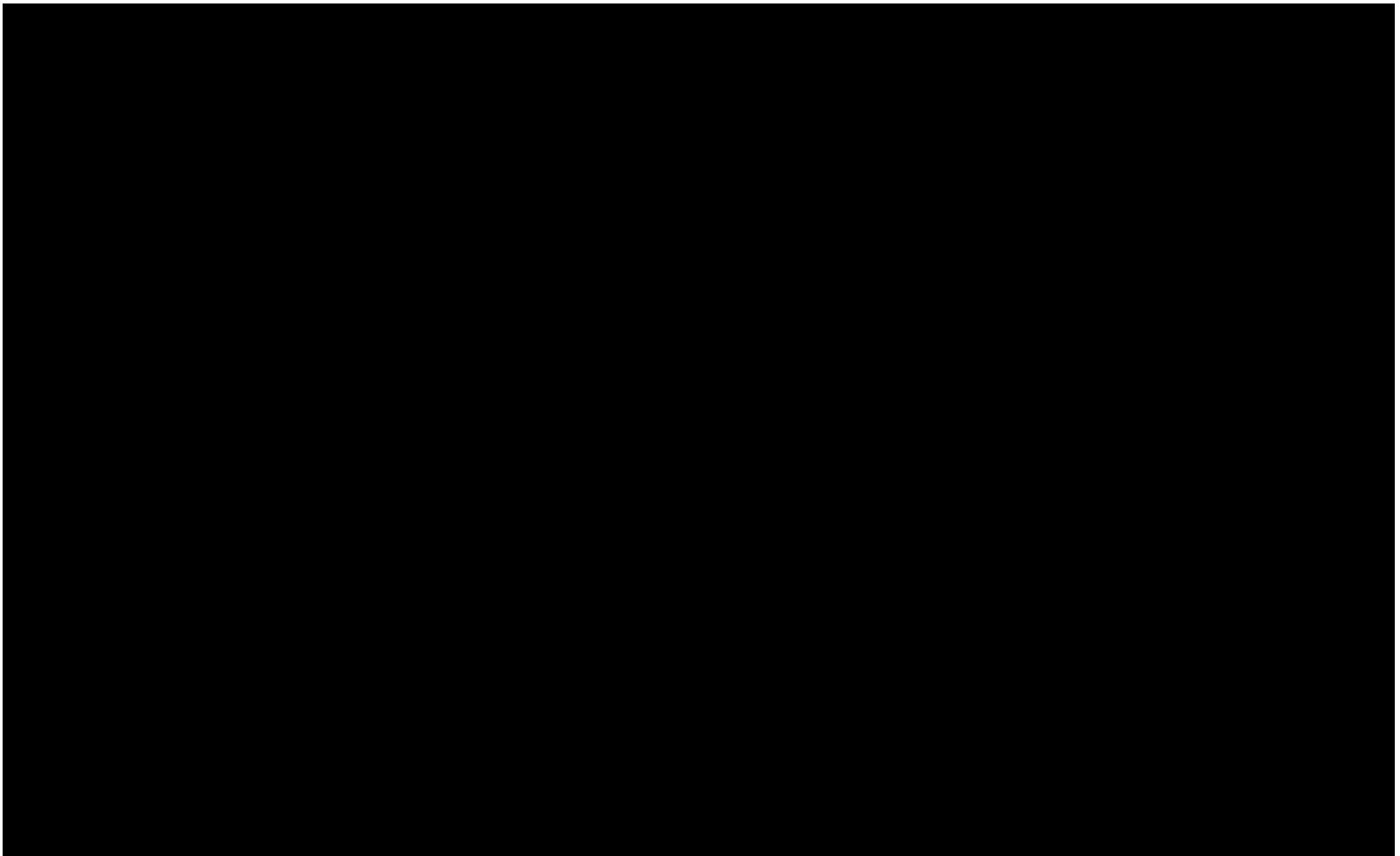
A fundraising competition during AIA Convention 2015 pitted member against member for ArchiPAC gold, with the goal of raising donations and awareness for the AIA's political action committee.
