Styrofoam Recycling: Block-style Styrofoam may be dropped off in the lobby of the Winnetka Public Works building at 1390 Willow Rd. from 7am - 5pm Mondays - Fridays through Friday, January 10. Neighboring communities are welcome to drop off. Last year the Styrofoam was recycled at Abt, but this year it is being picked up by Dart. The program may continue past January 10. More details to follow. Please spread the word about the program and that ONLY block-style hard Styrofoam is accepted at this time.

<u>Holiday Light Recycling</u>: Make the switch to LED holiday lights and recycle your old incandescent holiday lights in the lobby of the Winnetka Public Works building at the same time. Any SWANCC member community resident may use the drop off. String lighting and extension cords are accepted, but garlands, live greens, wreaths, and other non-recyclable items are not.
