

DESTINATION OVERVIEW

Providence, RI, known as the Creative Capital, features a compact downtown filled with historic architecture, world-class restaurants and eclectic shops, all within easy reach of hotels. Providence's dining and arts and culture scenes continue to draw the attention of the national media. The city itself was recently named "One of the 52 Places in the World to Visit in 2016" by The New York Times.

Meeting attendees have a variety of options for their free time in Providence. The RISD Museum at the Rhode Island School of Design is home to more than 91,000 works of art ranging from the ancient to the avant-garde. Theater lovers can take in a show at the beautifully gilded Providence Performing Arts Center or at the Tony Award-winning Trinity Repertory Company. And for those in the city during warm weather months, WaterFire is a can't-miss event. This multisensory art installation is comprised of a series of bonfires installed on the three rivers of Downtown Providence. Combining music, aromatic wood smoke, and crackling firelight to create an enchanting atmosphere, WaterFire is typically held on Saturdays from May through November.
