Chess: Learn the game of chess from setting up the board through checkmate including etiquette and strategy. All levels welcome.

DAEG Architecture and Design: Sketch and draft architectural plans and build models with a wide variety of materials.

DAEG Blast Off Math: Practice team building and math skills as you work collaboratively to solve creative math-based problems.

DAEG Cranium Challenge: Explore mathematical investigations and solve problems individually and collaboratively.

DAEG Investment Club: Learn the basics of investments and stock research. Invest "money," conduct research, buy and sell stocks and plot investments.

Girl Power!: Enjoy a fun, girl-centered time filled with a mix of talk, friendship, art projects, goal setting, exercises, and some healthy snack making.

Hands on Pottery: Hands on Pottery comes to Holmes. All materials are provided to paint your own pottery. Pieces are fired in the kiln at Hands on Pottery and brought back the next week.

Musical Theatre: Build confidence through music, theater, and movement. Sing, dance and learn how to project and bring a story to life in this performance-based class. Perfomance will be held the last day of class.

Om and Yum!: Yoga and Cupcake Club: Spend alternating weeks practicing yoga and meditation and decorating cupcakes with My Cupcake Club. Students learn decorating techniques each week and then design their own cupcakes.
