





#### ODOC Requirements for PWPI

- Insurance. Based on Risk Assessment;
   \$2M GL, \$2M Auto, WC = most orders.
- Bonding. Payment Performance required for PWPI >\$100K. Possible subcontracting opportunities. (Subcontractor opportunities)
- Supplemental Terms & Conditions (PWPI only).
- Bid bond mandatory for all PWPI bids.

### Small Purchases; <\$10K <u>Demystifying with ODOC</u>

- Make Contact!
   Be resourceful
   Find the point of contact
- Many opportunities are <u>not</u> posted on ORPIN.
- Most orders are <\$10K. = \$8,938,319.00</p>
- SPOTS purchases = \$7,047,402.00.

# Intermediate Purchases: >\$10K <\$150K Demystifying ODOC

- Invitation to Bid Documents posted on ORPIN.
- Special packaging, delivery requirements, etc.
- Restrictions on clothing for service contracts.

# Getting In Getting Out

- Requirements for contractors working inside an ODOC Institution:
  - Security Clearance (LEDS).
  - Must be scheduled.
  - Accounting for tool & materials.
  - Clothing Cannot dress like an inmate!
