

Emerging Small Business (ESB) Project Delivery

What is it??

- Statutorily mandated set-aside for exclusive bidding by ESB certified firms
- Current Biennium (2015-17) budget is \$3.5 million or 1% of the state highway fund
- Split evenly between ODOT's 5 Regions and Facilities



ESB Program Specifics

- **☑** All ODOT ESB projects posted on ORPIN (Search 'ESB')
- **☐ Contracts, by law, may not exceed \$100k**
- **☑** Obstacles removed: Bonds not required on public improvements up to \$100K
- ☑ On public improvements, 51% of the <u>labor</u> must be performed by ESB prime contractor's own workforce reflected in certified payrolls. You are the Prime!
- **☑** ESB projects will have mandatory pre-bid meetings.

2016 ODOT Disparity Study

PURPOSE

- To analyze whether there is a level playing field for minority- and women-owned firms in the Oregon transportation contracting industry.
- This information will help ODOT operate its federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program.
- ODOT's last disparity study was completed in 2011.
- Consultants Keen Independent Research is leading the 2016 disparity study and is in the process of finalizing the results.











ODOT Disparity Study Draft Results

Key Findings


- From 2010-14 MWESB firms received 11.7% of total contract dollars
- 27% of interested & qualified businesses in Oregon are MWESBs

Proposed Goal

- ODOT proposes a DBE goal for federal fiscal years 2017-2019 of 11.6%
- 5% race-gender neutral portion, 6.6% race-gender conscious

Recommendations

 ODOT should include all race groups as eligible to meet DBE goals on FHWAfunded construction and engineering contracts
