

Team Relays Equestrian

There is no canter at level A. All riders' must perform team relay at the walk or trot.

1. Teams in a division must be equal in number with either 2, 3, or 4 riders.
2. If the relay can be done safely, two teams may compete at the same time.
3. The clock starts when the nose of the team's first horse crosses the start line.
4. The clock stops when the nose of the team's second horse crosses the finish line.
5. Batons are prohibited; the next rider goes after the previous rider crosses the marked line.
6. Horse handlers, if used, must walk behind the horse's nose. If the handler passes the horse's nose at any time, that rider must make a circle at a walk before continuing.

Depending on course design, the course should be a total of 30 meters (98'5") for the walk only division, and 50 meters (164') for the trot division.
