We are looking for TTN members who have a passion for serious American and International films, from documentaries to feature films, to join and possibly share in hosting our monthly meetings. We are looking forward to sharing our film adventures with you.

Caregivers Support Group (for members of Caring Collaborative):

There are times in our lives when contact with like-minded individuals can make a profound difference. The group is open to TTN members who face the daunting challenge of dealing with loved ones who are seriously ill or are frail elderly. Foreign Film Friday: We are an informal group of movie goers that meets twice a week, the second and fourth Friday of each month, in the early afternoon, to see a foreign film, usually, in the Lincoln Center area. The group coordinator keeps the email list, but we share recommendations with the whole group and reach consensus by email on what to see. In order to connect with each other, once we agree on a film, we meet 10-15 minutes before it begins and wear something obvious, hat, scarf, coat, in Fire Truck Red. After the film, we all meet at Fiorello's for a drink, snack, and to chew over the film.

We are progressive in our orientation; however, we welcome all political ideologies
