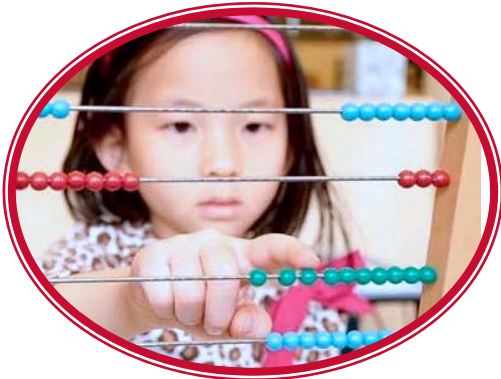

FIVE SUMMER SESSIONS

Session 1: Taking Care of Our Planet

June 13 - June 24

Students will experience:

- Fun lessons on planet facts
- The importance of water and our environment



Students in this session will learn all about taking care of our environment and the importance of water to life on Earth. Students will also get to visit the Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum.

Session 2: Music and Movement

June 27 - July 8

Students will experience:

- Different musical instruments
- Music from other cultures
- The lives of famous composers



Sometimes called “the universal language,” music will add a sensory dimension to this session. Students will also attend a special in-house

Session 3: Inventions & Discoveries

July 11 - July 22

Students will experience:

- Science Experiments
- Fun with physics

Students in session 3 will study science facts and learn about important discoveries and inventions. They will also experience fascinating experiments around topics such as gravity, electricity, or chemical reactions during an exciting in-class presentation by Mad Science.



Session 4: Animal Planet

July 25 - August 5

Students will experience:

- Animals and their habitats
- Animal life cycles
- Classifications of animals

Students in session 4 will study fascinating animal facts, including the amazing process of the butterfly lifecycle. They will also view and touch exotic animals during an in-house presentation by Animals for Awareness, a company which stresses the importance of life long commitment to our animal family members.



Session 5: Fire Safety & Healthy Habits

August 8 - August 19

Students will experience

- Fire safety education
- Food pyramid facts
- The difference between healthy and junk food



During this session students will learn different safety tips and healthy habits, including important nutrition education. They will also learn about fire safety in an in-house presentation from the Fire Department!
