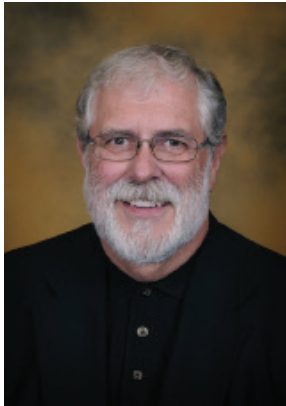


# Phillips Theological Seminary
