Master ADHD Management

Dr. Jensen's research programs address critical child mental health-related areas, that shed light on the optimal methods for treating Childhood Mental Disorders, and ensures that these new, optimal methods actually are applied in "the real world" so that children with mental health problems get optimal care as soon as it is needed.

His studies also focus on developing tools and methods that help parents and youth engage and participate as full "partners" with their doctors in mental health interventions.

One of his Key emphases in these research programs are applying the concepts of "engagement" (quickly building strong, collaborative relationships with children and parents) and "empowerment".

Through this program, participants will:

- Learn how to present evidence-based information about ADHD to patients and their families.
- Understand special challenges in assessing special populations for ADHD: preschoolers, adolescents, parents, complicated children.
- Learn to apply optimal ADHD therapy and medication treatment principles, for children with simple ADHD and with comorbid complications.
