Fajita Fiesta Cook Off Rules



NOTE: Only one (1) team per grill. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to 4 team members. Each team will have a 30-foot x 30-foot space. No electricity is provided. Campers are allowed. No pets are allowed. All equipment, supplies, and personal items must fit within your designated area. Please bring your own trash bags and deposit your trash in the dumpster. Keep your area clean at all times.



Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start the natural substances, but not to complete cooking. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. Grease traps must be utilized to prevent grease drippings on the grounds. **Each team MUST bring a fire extinguisher.**



Props, trailers, motor home vehicles, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space. No tent stakes can be driven into the asphalt.



Cook's Meeting will be held **Friday, September 23rd at 7 p.m** in the Judging area.

HEAD COOKS MUST ATTEND

- **Fajitas** – Beef skirt steak only, must be made on site
- **Beans** –Dry pinto beans, cooked on site, nothing bigger than the bean allowed. The only exception would be pork salt for cooking purposes only. Any entry with anything larger than the bean will be disqualified.
- **Salsa** – must be made on site – No Pico de Gallo, salsas only
- **Pan de Campo** (Cowboy Bread) – The Official State Bread of Texas, must be made on site
- **Carne Guisada** – cooks choice, must be made on site
- **Margaritas** – cooks choice, no pre-mix, must be made on site. Turn in will be **FRIDAY, September, 23rd**.

BASED ON THE NUMBER OF COOKS TURN-IN QUANTITIES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.



Meat Inspection will be held Friday, September 23, 2016. Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc. will not be allowed prior to the start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off promoter.



Limit one Jackpot entry per team per item
(Margaritas, Carne Guisada, Charro Beans, Homemade Salsa, Pan de Campo)



Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualifications. Alcoholic beverage rules must be followed (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants.



Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.



Set up of lodging or cooking equipment will NOT be allowed prior to registration.
*If you set up prior to space assignment, you WILL be moved.
