#### **Expectations of Participating Restaurants and Chefs**

To ensure consistency and quality, we ask that all guest restaurants and chefs meet the following expectations:

##### ***Restaurant Booths in our Gallery Row Area:***

- You must be staffed and open to our guests between 11:30 and 3:30 on both days of the event – Saturday, October 17 and Sunday October, 18.
- Offering should feature iconic dishes from your establishment and should highlight locally-sourced ingredients. Price your items to include a \$1 donation to Old Sturbridge Village for each item sold.
- You should be adequately staffed to cover any necessary breaks and lunch.
- Old Sturbridge Village will facilitate any necessary town permits.
- You and any of your staff will adhere to the same expectations and professional comportment as all museum staff, interns and volunteers.

##### ***Demonstrating Field-To-Table Chefs:***

- Demonstrating chefs must be available to do two (different) 30 minute presentations in our Bullard Tavern presentation area each day.
- Demonstrations should be of a signature dish that you are known for utilizing locally-sourced ingredients.
- Credit should be given to local farms and suppliers.
- Demonstrating chefs must adhere to the same expectations and professional comportment as all museum staff, interns and volunteers.

#### **Application Process**

To participate in *DIG IN: A Field-to-Table Festival* weekend, please submit the following application no later than August 31, 2015 in order to be considered. Old Sturbridge Village will confirm participation no later than September 12, 2015.

- Please submit completed application (see reverse of this sheet) along with completed Town Permit Form.
- Please include any special requirements you have such as electric hook-ups, water access, etc.
- All promotional materials are subject to Old Sturbridge Village approval.
- We are requesting all participants display supplied promotional materials for this event in their establishments and on social media.
