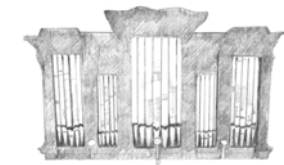
## CELEBRATING WOMEN COMPOSERS

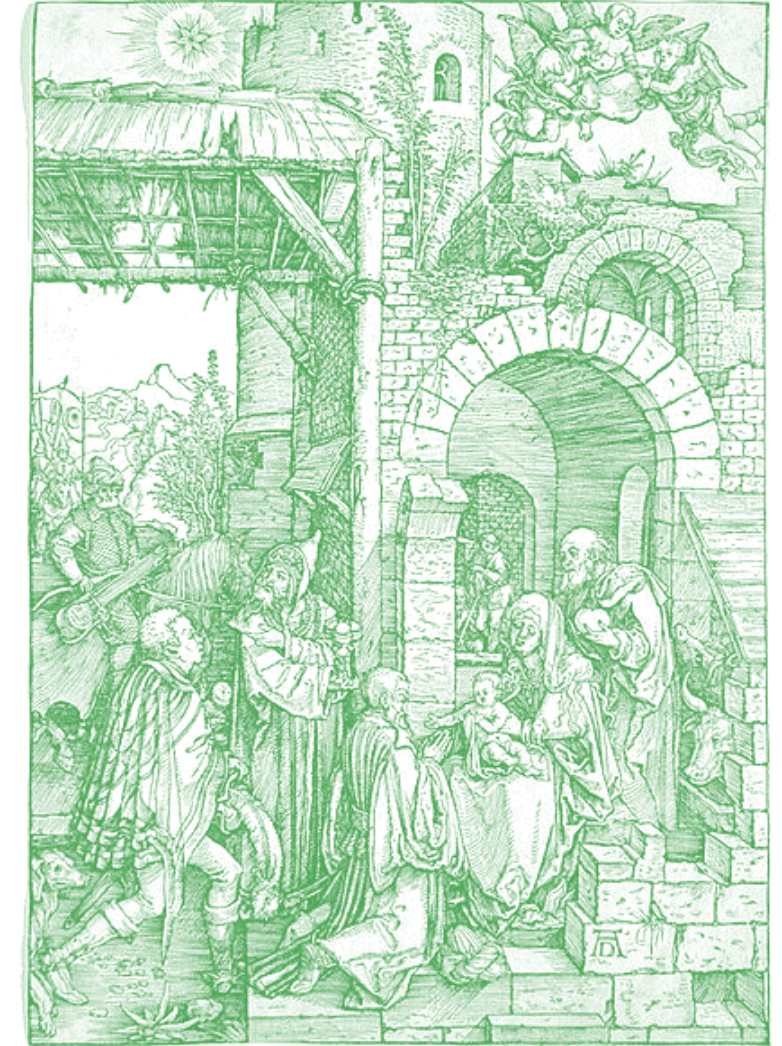
## THE CATHEDRAL MISSION STATEMENT
