NEW HAMPSHIRE'S WILD HISTORY: 350 YEARS OF NH WILDLIFE



The Wild History slide presentation takes participants on a virtual journey through New Hampshire's past, focusing on changes in the land and how wildlife populations have responded over time. You'll learn why changes in habitat in our past are behind the decline of many of our rarest species today, and what you can do to help.
