

INTERNATIONAL HUMANITARIAN AND DESIGN-BUILD OPPORTUNITY FOR IAPD STUDENTS

Professor Ryadi Adityavarman (IAPD) and Dragoslav Simic (ARCH) would like to develop a team of KSU students to participate in the International Bamboo Seminar and Exploration in Bandung, Indonesia. The event is part of the collaboration between Kansas State University and Universitas Parahyangan with the start of the seminar on July 29, 2015 and the workshop takes place on August 3- August 17, 2015.

The event organizer has agreed to provide full scholarship for up to 4 (four) participating KSU students for the event registration fee waiver, full support for accommodation and logistics for the entire workshop. In the workshop, KSU student team will collaborate with Indonesian architecture students to design and construct an experimental bamboo structure in a local Sundanese village. Thus the event will provide multiple learning opportunities from new cultural perspectives to design exploration with distinctive materiality in build project for a humanitarian cause.

The plan is to recruit potential interested students from both of IAPD and ARCH with suitable skills and interest for the project. The priority will be given to the graduating IAPD 5th year students due to variety of reasons. Prof. Simic and Adityavarman will review the submitted application for the team selection.
