

# Shakeup at the top!



Heads did roll on Tuesday as the Dow Jones Co. booted Alcoa (AA), Bank of America (BAC), and Hewlett Packard (HPQ) out of the Dow Jones Industrial Average.


The only question that I have about this move is...

WHAT TOOK SO LONG??????????????????

This is the biggest DJIA membership change to take place in almost ten years. Alcoa has been a member of the Dow for 54 years, HP a member for 16; and Bank of America for 5.

In my opinion, these stocks are getting kicked out because of their lousy performance against the market over many years. Again, what took so long?

Let's begin with Alcoa (AA).





Alcoa has returned an average of negative 10 percent per year over the last ten years! That is right-NEGATIVE 10 percent per year!

Over the last five years, it has done even worse than that. The stock has averaged negative 20% per year! It sounds like the folks at Dow Jones are picking stocks for their index just like many individual investors pick theirs. Buy big stodgy old company of yesteryear that have good name recognition-Microsoft, Cisco, Hewlett Packard, etc. etc.

It makes you wonder where the Dow would be today had they kept their list a little more current over at the Dow Jones Co.

Let's next check out another exile-Bank of America.

The shares have done a little bit better than Alcoa, but not by much!


Shares have averaged negative 6.4% per year over the last ten years, and that includes the dividends!

The stock has delivered an average -14% per year over the last five years. In addition to this the stock was down a gut-wrenching 63% in 2008! This is hardly normal "blue-chip" behavior.

Would Bank of America still be around today if it were not for the U.S. taxpayer?

Again, it makes one wonder where the Dow would be today if it had well managed companies in it, as opposed to mismanaged companies like Bank of America.

Two duds in a row, what about Hewlett Packard (HPQ)?

While the performance of Hewlett has not been as bad as the other two stinkers, it has not been very good either.

Shareholders cannot be too happy with the previous three and five year returns! Maybe Meg Whitman should sell her shares on Ebay (EBAY)!

# Again Dow Jones, what took so long?



Watch my analysis of a great stock that I own that was added to the Dow.

Let's begin this week's analysis of the market by looking at a current chart of the aforementioned Dow...




Is that a *head and shoulders* pattern that I see forming? Yes, it could be. I hope not, because head and shoulder patterns can be BEARISH. You can see the neckline at around 14,800 and the head at about 15,650.

Before we panic and jump off the bullish bandwagon, let's take a look at one-year chart of the Nasdaq...



The Nasdaq looks a whole lot better than the Dow. But then technology, small, and mid-cap stocks have led the market all year long. I am not ready to flee the market yet, but I need to see a lot more evidence to stay in. So far we have a shaky, but new and improved Dow, and a very strong Nasdaq. What about the current asset class rankings? Are we still on offense?

Here is my current ranking of the all-important asset classes. (I track a total of 45).



The top eight are still ALL **EQUITY** oriented. No fixed income and no precious metals. This trend has been in place all year long. There is some action finally going on in the international markets. They have lagged our markets badly all year long though.

As you can see from the lists above, the International small-cap index is now the number one ranked sector in the market. I featured it and showed you the components of this index in last week's newsletter.



Let's next take a look at 9-16 to see if anything interesting is going on there.




