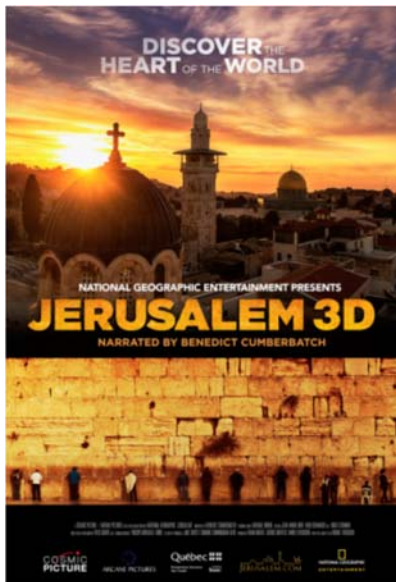


Dead Sea Scrolls and Jerusalem 3D IMAX
