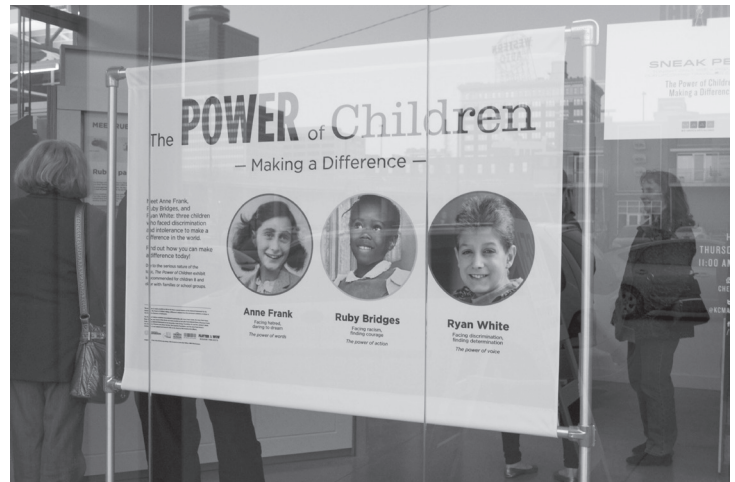
The POWER of Children at the EHC until October 20

Explore stories of Anne Frank, Ruby Bridges, and Ryan White - three children whose lives teach us about overcoming obstacles to make a positive difference in the world. Immersive environments bring visitors into the spaces where each child felt safe: the Secret Annex where Anne Frank and her family spent two years hiding; the first grade classroom in which Ruby Bridges spent an entire year alone with her teacher Mrs. Henry; and Ryan White's bedroom, filled with things he treasured. In this interactive, hands-on exhibit, children and other visitors will explore issues of isolation, fear and prejudice throughout 20th century history.
