Eligibility

The EHC Student Video Contest begins on May 10, 2016. It is open to all King County students in middle school, junior high and high school, and undergraduate students in King County colleges and universities.

Contest Rules, Originality and Video Requirements

- a) Video conveys clearly the topic selected.
- b) Video length must not exceed three minutes, including titles and credits.
- c) Video must be an original work, created entirely by the student or group of students. No professional assistance can be provided to produce your video.
- d) Music used in your video must be an original creation unless you have written consent. The use of trade names, trademarks, copyrighted materials or other intellectual property is prohibited, unless participants obtain the rights to such use and include documented authorization when submitting the video.

- e) Video cannot be objectionable, offensive in any way, violate any laws or the privacy of any person.
- f) Video must be recorded in English or include English subtitles.
- g) Video can be submitted as a file (.mp4, .wmv, .mov, mpeg, .flv, .avi) or as a DVD.
- h) Participants may submit more than one video.
- i) All videos with completed forms, written authorizations and releases must be submitted by September 15, 2016.
- j) Videos will not be returned.
- k) The Ethnic Heritage Council retains all rights, title and interests to the video named in this entry form.

Originality, topic communication and clarity

Winner Selection

Winners will be selected by a panel of judges composed of representatives from the video arts profession, education, community at large, and sponsoring organizations. One People’s Choice Award will be selected from online voting of the semi-finalist videos.
