

25,928	Consumers received services in 2015 from the eleven Independent Living Centers in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
228	Consumers transitioned from institutionalized settings such as Nursing Homes to the community. This is an estimated 4.5 million dollars in savings to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
365	Consumers are in the process of transitioning to the community <i>with additional consumers being identified each quarter through the outreach of the centers.</i>
11,257	Information and Referral calls received by centers, <i>From Consumers, Family Members, Partners in the community, Municipalities and Government.</i>
