Applications for the Autism Waiver Program must have a postmark or email date:

No earlier than Friday, October 16, 2015 and no later than Friday, October 30, 2015

Open Enrollment forms from November 2014 are discarded prior to the start of this October 2015 open enrollment. Therefore, you must apply again during this open enrollment period.

Clinics, Social Skills & Inclusion Grants

Participants for all groups MUST be Autism Division eligible, and under the age of 18. Parents must register within 30 days of request for funding.

Social Skills

Those who would like to enroll their child in a Social Skills Groups with a clinician may apply for funding, up to \$300.00 towards a group session. Funds will be sent directly to providers, and families would be responsible for any fees beyond \$300.00. If a provider charges less than \$300.00 the fee will be covered in total by the funding. Funding for social skills groups is limited to eligible candidates under the age of 18 who meet the criteria for participation as set by the clinician. Contact the Resource Center to secure possible funding by calling Donmarie Smith at 508-298-1609. Once your DDS status has been verified you your provider may invoice the Center for payment of \$300.00 for your child

Autism 101

When you first receive an autism diagnosis it can be overwhelming. There's the initial emotional shock, which is quickly followed by feelings of inadequacy as there is no manual for parenting itself, let alone parenting a child with an autism spectrum disorder. And there is SO much to learn.

Autism 101 is designed to help families who are new to the diagnosis gain a solid footing to begin their journey. This course is designed for parents new to the diagnosis, but is open to all parents who feel they may need a refresher or simply were overwhelmed when they first received the diagnosis and are now ready to take this course. Some individual sessions may be attended as noted, at a cost of \$5.00, as space allows.

To give parents a stronger foundation as they begin their journey, we include an on-line learning experience from UMass Medical School called UDiscovering: Discovering Behavioral Interventions. This interactive online course will be made available to parents who register for Autism 101 for a period of 3 Months. Going at your own pace, you will learn about ABA and thus be better equipped to meet the challenges of parenting your child on the spectrum. We are pleased to be able to make this affordable for parents.



Family Fun and Fitness

This will be the third year that we have offered this program to Families. Over time the program which takes place on Monday evenings , by default , has evolved to serve older teens and adults. Initially we walked every week, but last year we added an exercise component with Juli O'Mara, a certified personal trainer who also is autism saavy. We chose to work on Core Strengthening exercises since poor trunk control impacts so many aspects of functioning and is a common facet of the physical aspects of autism. This group is open to all with older teens and adults who need to work on improving their physical fitness. Many of those on the spectrum lack outlets for physical activity and tend to engage in sedentary recreational pursuits like computers and video gaming. Additionally the food aversions commonly seen in ASD help to establish poor nutritional habits.

To address this we will expand the program to include one night a month where participants will explore healthy eating choices through dining at health conscious restaurants and sharing food. This will bring a social aspect to the program while demonstrating better choices and expanding the food selections of participants. This is a Parent /Adult Child program but is open also to participation by and with shared living providers and staff from group homes. For parents of adults, the benefits are obvious, as the years of caretaking frequently lead us to be neglectful of our own health and needs. We hope you will join us. Tuition for the next three months is \$30.00/per family. Siblings and Parents are welcome to participate which will include personal training. Dining costs will not be included. In December the group will share a Pot Luck dinner. Parents of Younger Children may also subscribe to improve their health.
