
#### **Drawing, Painting & Sculpture Workshop**


#### Lacrosse Academy by CroArt Sports, South Shore Sticks and the Boston Cannons

At the end of the week, we will test our gliders competitively, and the champion will be recognized with a Certificate of Excellence in Aerospace Engineering.
