For the past 14 years, Dr. Bruce Forciea of Delafield has taught anatomy and physiology at Moraine Park. He is also a member of the Advancing Online Education committee at the College. His career in education has been a very rewarding one.

“I love working with students and helping them achieve their goals,” said Forciea. “I also love the challenge of finding new ways to engage students through technology, new teaching techniques and online learning. I feel that teaching is my life’s calling, and I am grateful to have the opportunity to help others in this capacity.”



In March, Forciea also represented Moraine Park as a speaker at the Innovations 2016 conference in Chicago with his presentation, “Producing Quality Audio and Video for Online Courses.”

In addition to teaching, Forciea also enjoys being a writer and has published several non-fiction books and eBooks. This past fall, he wrote his first full-length novel, *The X-Cure*. The novel is a science fiction thriller that pits a small group of scientists against a global pharmaceutical giant in a race to release a cure for cancer.

Some of his other works include a book about healing called, *Unlocking the Healing Code*; a study guide called, *An Easy Guide to Learning Anatomy and Physiology*; and a book about eLearning called, *Make Your Online Courses Rock*.

Forciea plans on publishing another novel later this year. It will be a cyber thriller that incorporates artificial intelligence, cybercrime, the FBI and an international cat and mouse chase. He has also written a few short science fiction stories, which he is in the process of submitting to magazines.
