

HOLLYWOOD COMES TO MORAINE PARK Tickets now available for 2016 Gourmet Dinner

The Moraine Park Foundation is rolling out the red carpet for this year's Gourmet Dinner, "Bright Lights, Hollywood Nights." The event combines the nostalgia of 1950s fare with the ambiance of old Hollywood. In addition to delicious cuisine, a wine-cork pull, silent auction and entertainment will be featured.

The event, presented by the Moraine Park Culinary Arts program, will be held Friday, April 29 at the Fond du Lac campus. The reception will begin at 5:30 p.m. followed by dinner at 7 p.m.

Enjoy a six-course meal consisting of popular continental menu items from the '50s with a little twist. Appetizers will start with a shrimp cocktail with three sauces followed by a chopped Caesar salad with anchovy, Sartori SarVecchio® Parmesan and egg pates. Asparagus infused consommé with Hollandaise flan soup will be served. The intermezzo will be bourbon old fashioned sorbet. For the main entrée, layered beef wellington with mushroom duxelle and rosemary red wine demi-glace, creamed Grände Aged Provolone spinach and horseradish duchess potatoes will be served. The meal concludes with dessert, a Baked Alaska with homemade ice cream.

The annual gourmet dinner will benefit the Moraine Park Foundation's general scholarship fund and the student emergency fund.
