



Tom O'Brien, a retired corporate lawyer, has been a parishioner at Bethesda-by-the-Sea since 1989. He served on the Vestry (1991-94), as Senior Warden (1992-94), as Chair of Adult Education from 1995 to 2012, and has taught Scripture and Theology courses since 1999. In January 2010, he was installed as a Canon of Trinity Cathedral, Miami. Tom served on the Diocesan Executive Board for eight years and was Secretary of the Diocese from 2006 to 2008. He taught Scripture at the Diocesan School from 2003 to 2007 and has been Chair of the Diocesan School Board since 2003.
