Cancellation Policy: We reserve the right to cancel a session if necessary because of circumstances beyond our control or when enrollment is deemed insufficient. In this case all payments you have made will be refunded – whether deposit only or full tuition amount.

Participant Cancellation Policy: For cancellations made more than 30 days in advance of the training, a full refund will be given. No refunds are given for cancellations made less than 30 days prior to the start of the training, but you may apply this tuition payment to

another training with Lucie Leclerc, that must be attended within one year of your cancellation date.

Animals attending the Training: due to space limitations, there will be a limit on the number of dogs, so **you must let us know at the time you register if you would like to bring your dog, and we will let you know if there are still spaces.**

If there is a question about your animal companion, the instructor will contact you.

If your dog will be attending, bring:

Crate, x-pen, or at minimum a mat or rug

Water bowl, food & treats

Evidence of up to date vaccinations or titer

Collar/equipment with ID tag, leash (other than flexis if that is what you normally use,) and any other equipment you normally use

Help us maintain good relations with our training facilities by:

- respecting the rules of the facility, and
- leaving the facilities as you found them.

You will be sent pdf documents by email prior to the class. You may wish to bring your own notebook as well for taking notes.

What to Wear: Comfortable clothing for bending, stretching, occasionally sitting on the floor. Dress in layers.

Meals: Meals are not included in the tuition. Water, coffee, tea, and light snacks are provided at the training facility. There will be a 60 minute break each day for lunch at around 12h30.

Location: The Toronto Humane Society is located in downtown Toronto, at the corner of Queen St and River St, just off the Richmond St exit of the Don Valley Parkway. Contact Bev Spotton for parking suggestions. It is also easily accessible by public transit (Queen streetcar east from Queen subway station, 7 minute ride to River St).
