



PAHH Update through February 3, 2016

Construction:

- Siding will be completed next week at the 1403 Tumbleweed Drive construction site in Chino Valley. Rough electrical, plumbing, and HVAC have been completed at this house, which will be home to PAHH's family #79.
- Rehab work is underway at 8085 Donna Dr. in Prescott Valley and 2121 Stellar Drive in Chino Valley for PAHH families #81 & 82. These families will be able to move into their homes in March.
- The final plat for PAHH's Madison Park Cottages project was approved by the City of Prescott in November 2015.
- PAHH now partners with the Coalition for Compassion and Justice to provide a critical home repair program that services the Tri-City region.
- Construction should begin on the house at 1415 Tumbleweed Drive in Chino Valley (PAHH family #83) in 2 weeks.

- The next PAHH volunteer potluck will be Friday, March 11, at 5:30 p.m.
